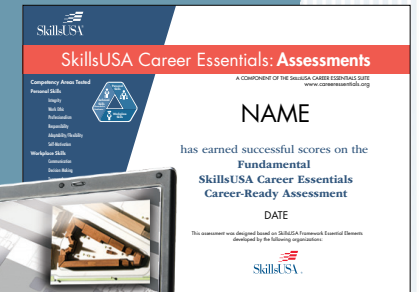

The integrity of each test is ensured by displaying the questions in varying order to prevent test-takers from copying. Each test must be administered under the supervision of a proctor.

Dynamic Reporting

Test results are available as soon as your students complete the assessment. Of course, you'll find the score and whether or not they earned the certificate. You'll also find gap analysis reports that show how your students performed according to each competency area. Dynamic reports compare your students' performance to the current state and nationwide averages and enable you to track progress of your students and program.

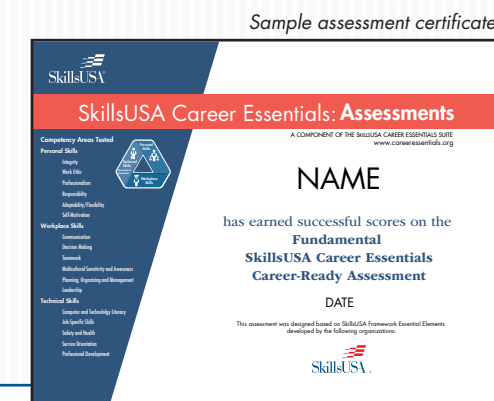

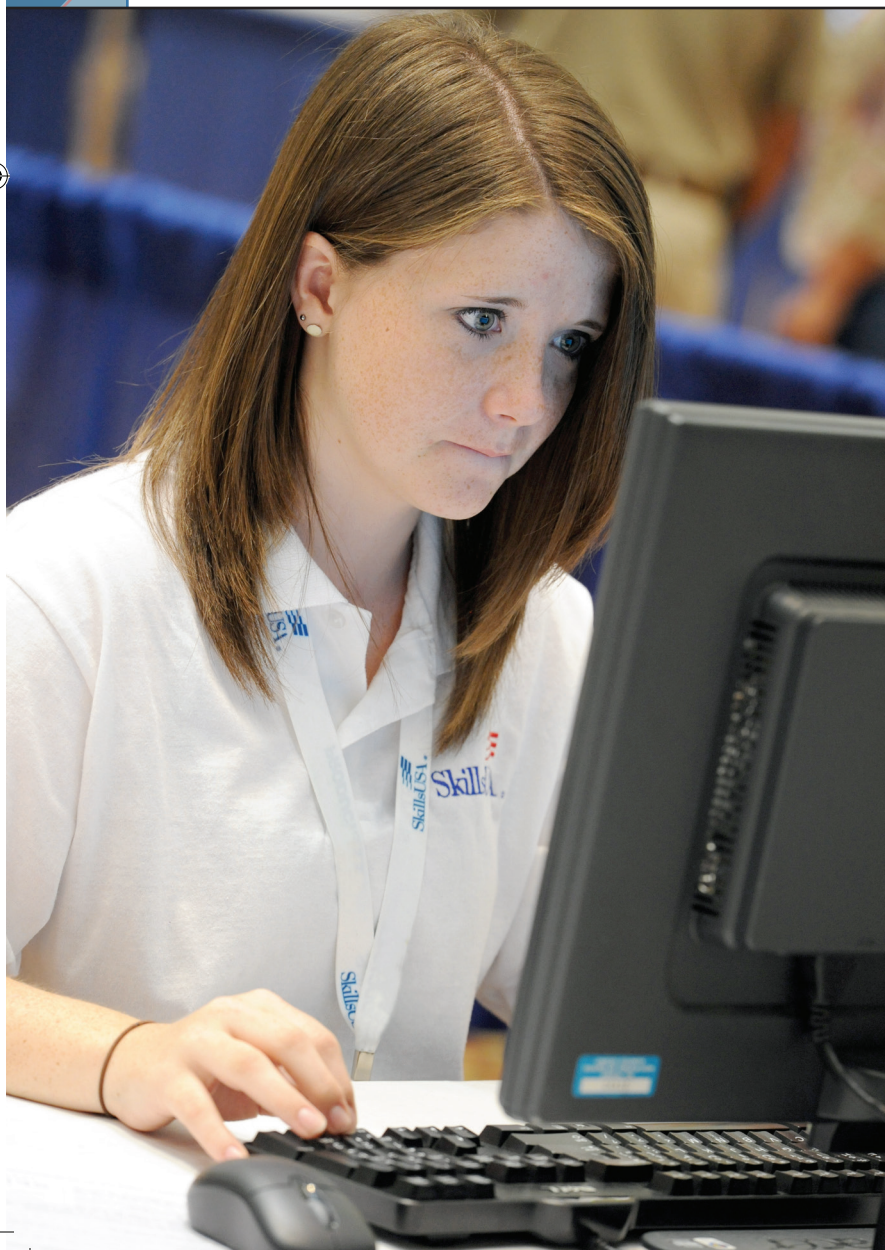
