

# Total Participation Plan (TPP)

The SkillsUSA Total Participation Plan (TPP) allows eligible students who are enrolled in technical, skilled and service occupations, including health occupations, to participate in SkillsUSA as an integral part of their education. That means your entire classroom, school or school district can join SkillsUSA on a single plan that covers national dues, state dues and educational resources for students. This flyer describes how you can use your allotted resource dollars under a TPP plan to order Career Essentials Curriculum access for students.

Follow these three steps to purchase Career Essentials Curriculum access for your students under a TPP agreement.

- 1. Pool your TPP dollars** or allocate funds at \$5.95 per student.  
Use the formula to calculate your allotted TPP dollars.

$\$5.95 \times \text{the number of students on your TPP plan.}$

TPP-schools pay the retail price for Career Essentials and use TPP allotted funds as credit towards their purchase.
